WORKSHOP

1 CARVING A SPOON—Friday, June 5th—cost \$110 Limited to 10 participants**

Bowls and spoons pair beautifully. Learn to carve your own spoon and welcome handcrafted objects into your daily life. This demonstration will guide you through sourcing wood and preparing spoon carving blanks. You will see a spoon emerge using traditional tools such as spokeshaves, gouges, and carving knives to shape your own spoon. Elizabeth will also explore finishing techniques to bring out the best in your handmade piece.

WORKSHOP 2 CARVING A WAVE/LEAF MOTIF—Saturday, June 6th—cost \$110.

Limited to 9 participants**

In this presentation we will explore how to interpret natural elements and incorporate these motifs into your turned objects. Elizabeth will walk us through the tools, tips, and techniques for creating these designs, including layout strategies and methods. We will cover the use of rotary carvers and woodburners for surface embellishment. Finally, we will look at different ways to bring color to your work using milk paint, and explore the finishing options available to complete and protect your piece.



WORKSHOP 3 TURNING AND EMBELLISHING BOXES—Sunday, June 7—cost \$110. Limited to 8 participants**

In this demonstration, I'll show you how I start with green wood to rough turn endgrain box blanks, including how I dry them. I'll walk you through my process for turning a finished box that's ready for embellishment, focusing on important details like thickness, lid fit, and grain orientation. I'll also share how I lay out my designs and the tools I use for carving and adding texture to each piece.

NOTE: Workshops will be approximately 8 hours, exact times of each workshop will be shared as soon as we have that information. Also, if we have enough interest, we will work with Elizabeth to try to add a fourth workshop.
